This page explains a few facts regarding the YMCA School's Out After-School Program for the 2011-2012 school year at the Graham Road West location:

After School Monthly Fees: Payments are to be made on a monthly basis by the 1st of each month.

5 days/week per month	\$210.00**
4 days/week per month	\$190.00*
3 days/week per month	\$170.00
2 days/week per month	\$145.00
1 day/week per month	\$125.00

* \$10.00 discount for families with additional child(ren).

** \$20.00 discount for families with additional child(ren).

- **Registration Fee** is \$30.00 for **New** School's Out registrants. The registration fee will be waived for those who participated in the School's Out Program previously.
- **Membership:** An Ithaca YMCA membership is required for each School's Out participant. A Youth membership is available as an Annual option for \$100.00 or a Bank Draft option for \$10.00 per month. The benefits of youth membership are: family swim, gymnasium, racquetball courts and reduced rates on all Y program fees.
- **Financial assistance** is available to those who apply and fall within qualification guidelines. For more information, please contact the YMCA at 257-0101.

Calculation of fees: The YMCA's School's Out fees are budgeted and based on a 10-month school year. Fees are estimated on a whole and divided into tenths. Fees do not change due to missed days, school closings, early dismissals or school vacation days.

Cancellation/Refund Policy: Monthly payments are non-transferable and non-refundable. Credits and refunds are not given for early removal (ie. mid-month) from the After School Program.

Full Days: For a list of Full Day Program options due to common school days off, please consult our "Full Day" flyer.

Emergency Care Fees: \$15.00 per day for members, \$25.00 per day for nonmembers.

Emergency care is available as a service to our youth and community with the following definitions only, without exception. Emergency Care is appropriate for the parent/guardian/authorized pick-up person in the event of:

- * Medical circumstances & unplanned hospitalizations beyond their control
- * Vehicular accidents
- * Last minute/unannounced business meeting, appointments, or business trips
- * Unplanned overtime hours by employer
- * Legal detention
- * Natural or man-made disasters

Emergency Care recipients may only be approved by the Youth & Family Director.
