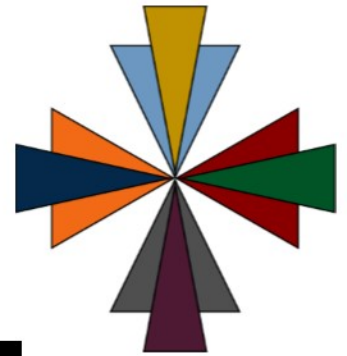




Do-It-Yourself Bird Feeder

Spring is here! Birds are hopping around and tweeting! Here's another fun activity that everyone can do while staying home. We are going to make a bird feeder using materials that you can find around the house, as follows:

- Peanut butter
- Bird seed
- Hole punch
- String, yarn, dental floss, or even an old metal coat hanger
- A toilet paper roll

First make a hole with in the toilet paper roll
Now using a butter knife, spread peanut butter all over the TP roll

I would suggest pouring the bird seed onto a plate and then turning the peanut butter roll over the bird seeds.
Secure your bird feeder with string, yarn, dental floss or anything else that you use so it can be hung up.

Once that is all done, find a place where you can hang your bird feeder and start watching. While watching, identify each type of bird (did you give each bird a name?), the time of day they're seen eating, and decide what your favorite type of bird is.
